EYEWITNESS INTELLIGENCE REPORT ON CENTRAL AMERICAN SITUATION:

A personal friend of mine, an ex-Green Beret, whom I trust implicitly, has just returned from an extended visit to Central America. He gives the following report, which I pass on for your information:

U.S. troops have been actively engaged in combat operations on the Honduras side of Rio Coco/Reo Negro, on April 21, 22, and 23. A major Sandinista attack was made against Contra positions on these dates and 80 rounds of BM 21 "Stalin Organ" rocket fire fell on American positions during one four hour period.

He states that Honduran troops were relatively well trained along conventional battle lines, but were deficient in guerrilla warfare skills. The unit commanders prefer to remain in defensive positions during the night and take their chances of a chance encounter with the Sandinista patrols during the day.

He found over 1,000 Claymore mines in one ammo dump, that the indigenous personnel did not know how to use. A small cadre of Contras have since been receiving training in their use. These mines were credited with saving the Contra camp during the April 21st rocket attack.

Ten former Special Forces men, including my friend, have left for Honduras to train indigenous troops. This is not a government operation, but is being sponsored and financed by personnel in the U.S. who recognize how important it is that we save Central America. From the actions of the U.S. Congress, it appears that they will still be arguing support for the Contras, when Communist troops goosestep into Los Angeles.

MEXICAN SITUATION: The U.S. Government is currently arming the pro-Communist Mexican Army with modern American military arms, M-16, M-79, M-14. Contacts within Mexican intelligence report that more Soviet Advisors are arriving during July. There have also been further sightings on Russian tanks and aircraft. The Mexican political situation is extremely unstable and recent arrests of major drug smugglers have revealed information that official corruption is sufficient to create the unrest necessary for a Communist takeover.

EL SALVADORE: Anti-Communists are coming under attack on all sides. The government troops are definitely winning when they are allowed to fight, but the situation is becoming reminiscent of Vietnam.

NICARAGUA: The FDN is the only viable anti-communist force currently working against the Sandinistas and they do not have the internal corruption found among the other anti-communist forces. Pastora is widely recognized in Nicaragua as a communist who wants to set himself up as a Castro style dictator. U.S. operations to aid the Contras apparently is designed to only appear as support for the anti-communists, when in fact our government has prevented any meaningful operations against the communists. This information has been kept from the American people through the controlled media.

HONDURAS: The U.S. signed the same defense agreement with Honduras that we signed with South Vietnam. This document was signed May 2, 1985. The entire army is being rearmed with U.S. weapons and several hundred million dollars worth of military equipment is being "lost and abandoned" in Honduras, from the BIG PINE military exercises to circumvent any Congressional control. U.S. bases in Honduras have been enlarged to handle a large number of "expeditionary" forces.

The U.S. supported government of Suazo is using illegally trained riot police to terrorize the common population. These police are being trained by the U.S. by Special Forces personnel, apparently to prop up the Socialist government, which would fall within a matter of hours without intervention, as the present Honduran government is not at all popular with the man on the street, and contrary to news reports is not a strong anti-communist government.

The U.S. State Department has fabricated false charges against Gen. Alvarez Martinez, the only strong anti-communist leader, to prevent him from running for President. Martinez has the public and military support necessary to win this election, but is being deliberately hindered by our State Department.


Doesn't the above sound familiar? Our Communist infiltrated State Department did it in China, they did it in Korea and Vietnam, and now it appears that they are setting us up for war and defeat in Central America. When will our people wake up and demand a house-cleaning. In all of Mr. Reagan's anti-communist rhetoric, I have never heard him say anything about a "house cleaning" which is extremely necessary in the State Department and is long overdue. We have men operating within this branch of government, which are doing things which a hundred years ago would have brought charges of treason, resulting in conviction and execution as traitors, under Article III, Section 3 of our U.S. Constitution. Yet for over forty years, they have remained unchallenged no matter whether Republicans or Democrats have been in office.

My informant goes on to say: "Jack, I am firmly convinced from conversations with people whose names I cannot use in this letter, that the intent of the U.S. Government is to get us involved in a Vietnam style war in Central America within the next year, with the excuse that it will help the economy. All indications from my extensive on the ground inspection indicate that the U.S. has already been in combat in Honduras for four years. American advisors are now accompanying Honduran troops in actions on the frontiers of Nicaragua. This is not a conjecture, as I have had this confirmed directly from a high ranking Honduran Army officer and have had secondary confirmation from U.S. Army personnel who have actually been involved in this type of activity. One other confirmed item. Recall the two jets and the big 'chopper' we lost recently down there? One of the jets was shot down by the Sandinistas, as was the helicopter. Anyone interested in helping stop this can send materials of any type needed in tropical jungle operations, such as Vietnam issue boots (small sizes), compasses, small size fatigues (which can be purchased used from most Army Supply stores) and anything else which will be of help."
